

## BROIDA-HIRSCHFELDER FELLOWSHIP FOR FALL QUARTER COVER SHEET 2015-16

### Overview

The UCSB Shoreliners (formerly the UCSB Faculty Women's Club), with matching support from Graduate Division, will make two awards from the Broida-Hirschfelder Endowment. This award provides a total stipend of \$8,000 for Fall 2015 to domestic and/or international students from the following departments:

Biomolecular Science and Engineering; Chemical Engineering; Chemistry and Biochemistry; Computer Science; Earth Science (Geological Sciences); Ecology, Evolution and Marine Biology; Electrical and Computer Engineering; Environmental Science and Management; Geography; Marine Science; Materials; Mathematics; Mechanical and Environmental Engineering; Molecular, Cellular and Developmental Biology; Physics; Psychology (only physiological or experimental emphasis are eligible); and Statistics and Applied Probability

### Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants:

- Must be either registered or on official Leave of Absence in Spring Quarter 2015
- Must be registered in Fall 2015
- Must be in academic good standing at the time of application
- Must be within time-to-degree or normative time standards
- Must be advanced to candidacy at the time of application

### Award Determination

The Broida-Hirschfelder Endowment will provide the award for the fall of 2015. Decisions will be made by June 2015. The recipients of the award will receive an \$8,000 total award and will be honored at a luncheon in October.

- Personal narrative, maximum 2 pages, single-spaced; describe your background, career goals, and work experience in any of the above-mentioned departments; indicate your financial need and any unusual or difficult circumstances you have had to, or continue to, overcome in the course of your education.
- 1 letter of recommendation from the student's mentor. Please evaluate the project and qualification of the applicant.
- Curriculum Vitae (2-page maximum, single-spaced)
- Description of research project (one to two pages, single-spaced, written for a general audience)
