



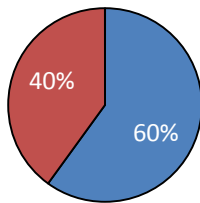
# Classics Graduate Degree Program

## Department Statistical Highlights

- We provide a rigorous academic training in a small and collegial department. In the last three years we have graduated 5 PhD students and 7 MA students.
- Our 100% placement record for PhDs is partly due to our excellent training in teaching as well as research. All of our PhDs are given the opportunity to teach Latin and Greek courses. For the last three years Classics students have won the Dean's Teaching Prize, an award that enables PhD students to teach an upper division course of their own devising: invaluable experience.
- 100% of our current students who need funding are fully funded. We now have funding for international as well as US students. We also have competitive funds for student participation in conferences and research projects.

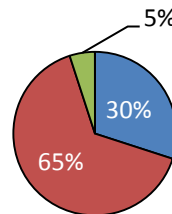
