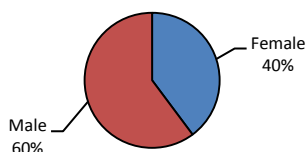

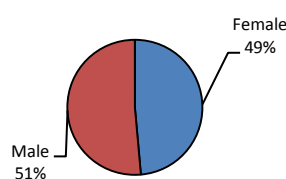

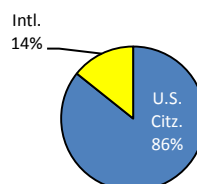
ERTSC (PhD)¹
Gender



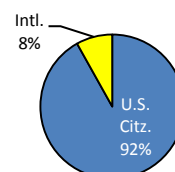
ERTSC (MS)¹
