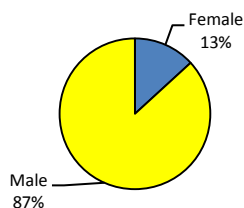

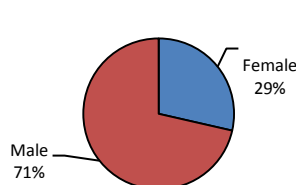

(Gender)



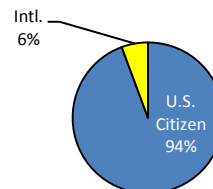
National²

(Gender)



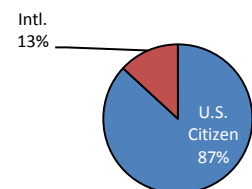
UCSB¹
