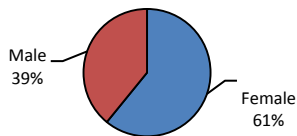

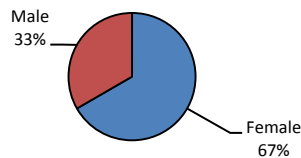

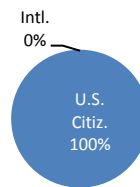
THTDA (PhD)¹
Gender



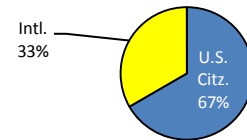
THTDA (MA)¹
