Overview

Award is given to assist talented graduate students in education, social sciences, fine arts, and humanities to pursue original research. Since these disciplines traditionally have limited access to extramural funds, this program's purpose is to help redress an imbalance in funding for graduate research. Doctoral or MFA domestic and international students may apply.

Eligibility

To be eligible, students:

- Must be advanced to candidacy at time of application or have completed at least 9 registered UCSB quarters up through Spring 2021
- Must not have previously received this award
- Must be registered in Spring 2021
- Must be in academic good standing at the time of application
- Must not be beyond time-to-degree standards through Spring 2021

Support

Awards are for \$3,000 maximum. The committee may award a lesser amount than requested by the applicant. Awards will be disbursed by the end of June. The student's faculty advisor is responsible for confirming the proposed activity does take place with expenses consistent with the awarded proposal.

Award Determination

Awards will be based on the academic significance and originality of the project, its feasibility-- especially within the specified time frame -- the qualifications of the applicant in relation to the project, and the clarity and appropriateness of the budget. Awardees will be notified by mail, in care of the campus academic departments, in May of the current year.
