Overview

The UCSB Shoreliners (formerly the UCSB Faculty Women's Club), with matching support from Graduate Division, will make two awards from the Broida-Hirschfelder Endowment. This award provides a total stipend of \$8,000 for Fall 2022 to domestic and/or international students from the following departments:

Biomolecular Science and Engineering; Chemical Engineering; Chemistry and Biochemistry; Computer Science; Earth Science (Geological Sciences); Ecology, Evolution and Marine Biology; Electrical and Computer Engineering; Environmental Science and Management; Geography; Marine Science; Materials; Mathematics; Mechanical and Environmental Engineering; Molecular, Cellular and Developmental Biology; Physics; Psychology (only physiological or experimental emphasis are eligible); and Statistics and Applied Probability

Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants:

- Must be either registered or on official Leave of Absence in Spring Quarter 2022
- Must be registered in Fall 2022
- Must be in academic good standing at the time of application
- Must be within time-to-degree standards
- Must be advanced to candidacy at the time of application

Award Determination

The Broida-Hirschfelder Endowment will provide the award for the Fall of 2022. Decisions will be made by June 2022. The recipients of the award will receive an \$8,000 total award and will be honored at a luncheon in October.
