- Do they have outdoor/indoor play areas?
- What is their sick child policy?
- How far is it from your home/work?
- How long is the school day?
- Do they have early drop off, after-school care?
- What is your gut telling you?

Things to look for on your visit/observation:

- School and classroom environment: Is it clean and safe?
- How do the teachers interact with the students?

Does the teacher:

- join in activities?
- bend down and make eye contact?
- appear to be attentive, patient, positive and uncritical?
- Are there ample creative play materials available?

Are children allowed:

- to do things by themselves and learn from their mistakes?
- time to choose their own activity?
- to be creative and use their imaginations?
- opportunities to play with a wide variety of toys and learning materials?
- Do the children appear happy to be there?
